What You'll Do:

The Data Warehouse Developer determines complex systems data warehouse design requirements including researching, analyzing, designing, documenting, and modifying specifications throughout the production life cycle. You will communicate with users to gain understanding of needed modifications to existing programs and processes and work to enhance existing solutions. You also may develop, maintain, and modify data policies, procedures, tools, data sets, data loads, documentation, and other data solutions.

You will also analyze and interpret collection of data, spot trends, modeling data sets and data architectures, and develop and enhance the data warehouse environment. The DWD will also collaborate and train cross-functional team members within the SCRUM/Agile framework, and provide occasional on-call support of data warehouse issues and perform diagnosis of hardware issues. You will also ensure that data warehouse improvements are successfully implemented and monitored to increase efficiency.

Qualifications:

- BS degree in Information Technology/Computer Science or equivalent combination of education and experience.
- Minimum of three years of demonstrated experience in full information life cycle, SCRUM/Agile methodologies, including but not limited to successful deployments as lead.
- Minimum of three years of demonstrated experience in the Microsoft Technology Stack including but not limited to SQL Server, Management Studio, SSIS, and SSRS.
- Minimum of three years of demonstrated experience with data modeling and transformation using standard ETL tools and methods.
- Experience writing complex SQL queries with Microsoft SQL and MySQL.
- Minimum of three years of demonstrated experience with Git and software version control best practices.
- Knowledge and experience with secure data practices, and state and federal information security laws, including but not limited to HIPAA, NIST, PCI and all other applicable regulations.
